<p>SEMP AND INTERNATIONAL GRANTS</p>	<p><u>ERASMUS COUNTRY STUDENTS</u> <u>SWISS EUROPEAN MOBILITY PROGRAM – SEMP</u></p> <p>Switzerland is not associated to the Erasmus+ program anymore. An interim solution, the Swiss-European Mobility Program, provides grants for both incoming mobility as well as outgoing.</p> <p>Erasmus country students coming from DK, FI, IS, IE, LI, LU, NO, SE, UK partner schools, will receive CHF 1'900.- for their exchange semester at HEAD – Genève.</p> <p>Erasmus country students coming from AT, BE, BG, CY, CZ, DE, EE, EL, ES, FR, HR, HU, IT, LT, LV, MK, MT, NL, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK, TR partner schools, will receive CHF 2'200.- for their exchange semester at HEAD – Genève.</p> <p><u>EXTRA-EUROPEAN COUNTRIES (NON SEMP)</u></p> <p>Students coming from developing countries may receive international mobility grants on a case-by-case basis. Students provided with such a grant would receive up to CHF 3'750.- for their exchange semester at HEAD – Genève.</p>
