

ALEKSANDAR MIJATOVIĆ

Born in Belgrade in 1964. He graduated from the School of Design in Belgrade in 1982 at the Department of Graphic Design. He enrolled at the Faculty of Applied Arts in 1984 at the Department of Interior Architecture and Furniture.

After graduating in 1989, he is actively involved in design, construction and consulting in the field of interior architecture, architecture and furniture. For the past thirty years, he has successfully performed over 550 author projects on the territory of Serbia, Croatia, Republika Srpska, the Federation of BiH, Montenegro, Greece, Spain, Germany, France, Belgium, Austria, Portugal, Czech Republic, Belarus, Syria and Panama.

He began his academic career in year 1993 as an assistant trainee at the Department of Interior Architecture at the Faculty of Fine Arts in Belgrade. Since 2001 he became an assistant professor at the same department, and since 2009 an associate professor in the subject of Interior Architecture. He became a full professor in 2017. In addition to the basic ones, as a mentor he holds the second and third degree of studies.

He took over the position of Vice-Rector of the University of Arts for the field of international cooperation in October 2021.

In the period from 2004 to 2010, he was hired as an advisor to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia for interior works on the facilities of consular and diplomatic missions abroad.

From 2016 to 2021, he served as a member of the board of directors of the Museum of Applied Arts in Belgrade.

He is a member of the Association of Architects of Serbia, UIA. The International Union of Architecture, ACCEE. Architects Council of Central & Eastern Europe
