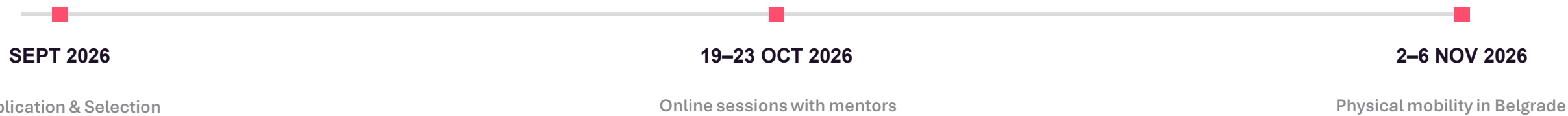

THE CONCEPT

BELGRADE AS INTERSECTION

We invite art students to engage in research-based work grounded in the specificity of place - taking Belgrade's urban fabric as a case study.

Belgrade's identity has always been shaped by its geopolitical position as a crossroads between East and West: a meeting point where civilizations, routes, desires, and interests of power intersect. Its urban tissue is layered like a patchwork, in constant contact with contradiction - a city perpetually conquered, demolished, and rebuilt, where nothing is permanent, where the intimate is always simultaneously political, and where the visible and invisible, remembered and imagined, coexist.

Engage with this urban palimpsest in workshops that approach the city as an attentive observer would: gradually revealing itself, yet never fully resolved, opening space for non-linear research, the awakening of inner content, imagination, and creative interpretation. Explore Belgrade through artistic and research practices - including, but not limited to, walking-based methodologies, psychogeography, spatial mapping, and interdisciplinary investigation - reflecting on the socio-political dimensions of place, memory, and transformation.

KEY METHODS

Alongside lectures and case-study presentations, the core teaching method will be the *act of walking* - collective and individual research-based, psychogeographic walks that allow for a redefinition of space and the uncovering of what is less visible or invisible, woven into the locality itself.
